

This service is for young people aged 16-30 years old struggling with day-to-day living, common problems that occur in society, family and in-law relationships, judicial unjust, behaviour and treatment, that aims for genuine respect for young males. We offer advocacy for complaints raised against police and judicial bodies.



The purpose of Men4justice is to give young men a safe place, hope, choice, a voice, deposit box (listening ear) options and advice

We advocate with complaints against police and social justice if any complaint wants to be raised we will be their advocate to ensure that the matter has been recorded, and monitored.



Men4Justice and its services are needed in the male community because society has isolated them from showing feelings and being able to discuss their issues, problems, or even valid opinions.
