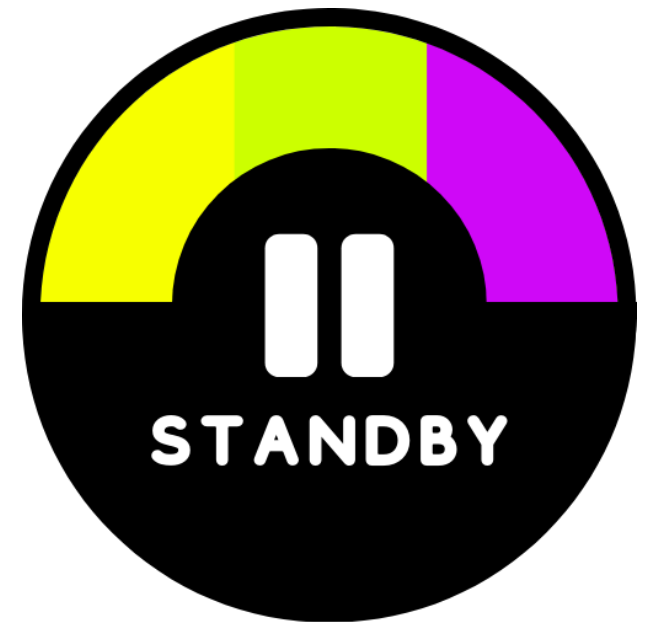

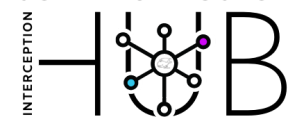

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- **You have been arrested, or engaged in a voluntary interview and released with an NFA Outcome, pending investigation or on bail**
- **We will need permission from you and may need permission from your parent/appropriate adult (age dependant) to have your contact information**
- **The custody based service will make the referral to us**
- **We will get in touch and get to know more about you and explain what we can offer you**
- **We move forward based on what you want**
